WHAT'S A 5-DAY CLUB?

A *5-Day Club* is a neighborhood Bible club, for children ages 4-11. They meet for five consecutive days, 1 1/2 hours a day. A hostess invites the children, provides a place to meet such as backyard, family room, porch or even a park, and prepares a snack.

A local director or summer missionary arranges clubs. The Bible lesson is from the *One Way* series, and the missionary story is of *Amy Carmichael*.

WHAT'S IT ALL ABOUT?

Child Evangelism Fellowship® sponsors Christian Youth in Action® (CYIA®). This is a Bible-based, non-denominational

organization, which strives to share the Gospel message to children and establish them in the Word of God and in local churches. Through CYIA and 5-Day Clubs®, young people join together to reach the next generation with the Good News. You can experience the joy of leading children to believe in Jesus as their Savior and help them learn more about Him.

WHO IS IT FOR?

CYIA combines the passion and energy of committed youth with intensive training focused on sharing the Gospel with children.

CYIA is designed for born-again believers, age 13 or older. The classroom instruction and the hands-on teaching experience train students to teach summer 5-Day Clubs.

WHERE IS IT LOCATED?



The training will be held at Camp Assurance near Belden, NE.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

CYIA is learning new ministry skills, meeting exciting challenges, making new friends, and finding joy in Serving Jesus Christ. **Registration**—Sunday, May 20th from 3:00-5:30 p.m. CYIA begins with supper at 5:30 p.m.

The Schedule:

The schedule will be focused on classroom instruction, directed study time, practice time and evaluations.

Sample classroom sessions include...



- Preparing a Bible lesson.
- Sharing the gospel through the Wordless Book.
- Counseling a child to Christ.
- Making song time meaningful.
- Teaching the saved child.
- Presenting a missionary lesson.
- Organizing a 5-Day Club.

As part of your CYIA training, you will be evaluated while teaching your first 5-Day Club with real children, using the materials learned. This usually happens the week after CYIA.

Students are asked to devote at least two weeks to the summer ministry, teaching 5-Day Clubs, VBS or Fairs. This can be done around vacations, sports, camp, mission trips etc. To help us plan the summer we ask you to indicate what weeks you can be available on the application.

WHAT DOES IT COST?

\$200 Early Registration
(By May 3th)

(After May 3th)

Tuition covers room, board, and necessary teaching materials.

A \$50 deposit is *required* with the application. Balance is due at CYIA registration. (Full tuition may be sent in with the application.)

WHAT ABOUT SUPPORT?

Your church will want to pray for you and may want to give towards your training costs. Many believers consider it a blessing to help you evangelize children by giving and praying for you.



You may also choose to get paid for your summer ministry as you teach the 5-Day Clubs.
